teenage human heads to one Yakubu Akwanga in Akwanga town, Nassarawa State. Kayode noted that detectives had mounted a man-hunt for

Yakubu Akwanga to get to the roots of the heinous crime. Meanwhile, the command

said it had also arrested two students of the Federal Polytechnic, Bauchi, for alleged armed robbery. The police commissioner said

seven locally-made pistols and some undisclosed number of ammunition was recovered from the suspects.

The command also recovered more than N174,000 cash and an army uniform during two separate encounters with suspected armed robbers operating along Bauchi-Jos and Bauchi-Tafawa Balewa roads, he said.

Kayode added that all the suspects will soon appear in court.
