Two Condemned To Death Over Murder

An Ile-Ife High Court has sentenced two persons to death over the killing of a former member of Osun State House of Assembly, Mr. Odunayo Olagbaju.

Delivering judgment recently, Justice Timothy Awotoye said Ekundayo

Oduntade and Adegbaju Olaolu were found guilty as charged.

Awotoye, however, discharged the third accused person, Kayode Ogundele, for want of evidence.

He said the court was convinced beyond doubt

that the two accused persons were involved in the gruesome murder of Olagbaju and deserved to die. The condemned persons were immediately moved to Ilesa Prisons.

Olagbaju, who represented Ile-Ife Central constituency, was

assassinated on the night of December 19, 2001 in his hometown, Ile-Ife.

Eleven people were initially arraigned before the high court, but the charges against the other eight accused persons were dropped as they reportedly jumped bail.
