

# Two Die In Auto Crash

Two persons were killed in separate motor accidents in Lagos at the weekend.

In the first accident, a bus conductor attached to a transport company in Lagos fell off the vehicle on motion. The incident occurred on Saturday.

It was learnt that the conductor, one Nwagbara Ndubuisi, who until his death worked with G.M.C Bus marked XM 169 ENU, fell off from the moving vehicle at Agboju bus stop, near FESTAC and sustained varying degrees of injuries.

He later gave up the ghost at a nearby hospital where he was admitted, while receiving treatment. Also a hit-and-run bus driver ran into a commercial motorcyclist killing the Okada man instantly.

The driver of the Toyota Hiace Bus marked XH 894 EPE ran over the Okada operator, who was identified as Fedeyiwa Oluwatosin at Second Rainbow Bus Stop, along Oshodi-Apapa Expressway on Saturday crushing him.
