

One Killed In Auto Crash

•As Lorry Crushes Bus Conductor

An unidentified driver was killed when his car collided with a commercial bus in Lagos recently at Lagos-Epe Expressway.

The car, a Toyota Carina II saloon car, marked CF 585 LND (Lagos), ran into a commercial bus marked XH 627 LND (Lagos) driven by one Muritala Sule at Gedegede bus stop.

The two drivers and an unidentified passenger of the

commercial bus sustained injuries. However, the car driver died while on admission at a nearby hospital.

Lagos State Police Command spokesman, Mr. Olubode Ojajuni, confirmed the accident. According to him, the corpse of the victim had been deposited at a public mortuary in Lagos for autopsy.

In a related development, a bus conductor was killed when a lorry ran into the vehicle in which he was operating on Tuesday, August 29, 2006 at Agboju bus stop, Lagos-

Badagry Expressway.

The driver of the 911 lorry hit the commercial Volkswagen bus marked XF 613 BDG at the rear before crushing the conductor.

Spirited efforts to revive the victim, however, proved unsuccessful as he died shortly after he was admitted at a nearby hospital.

Immediately after the ugly incident, the driver of the lorry took to his heels. The bus conductor was later identified as More.
