

Bus Kills Two-Year-Old Boy

A commercial bus has killed an unidentified male boy, who was playing with his peers in a street in Lagos.

The incident happened on Thursday at Iyalode Street, Ajegunle, Apapa. The bus, a Volkswagen Faragon marked Lagos XH 746 EPE, was driven by one Ikechukwu Agana.

The bus was said to have rammed into the playing web of kids, who were running after one another on the street.

The boy, about two years old, died on the spot.

Traffic policemen from Ajegunle Division had removed and deposited the corpse at a public mortuary in Lagos for post-mortem examination.

The Lagos State Police Command spokesman, Olubode Ojajuni, confirmed the accident.

According to him, the boy was suspected to have come from a nearby street to play with his peers before he met his untimely death.

In another development, goods and property running into millions of naira were razed when a mysterious fire gutted a popular market in Lagos on Thursday.

The fire broke out at Oju-Olobun market, Ebute-Ero, Lagos Island, late in the evening. It affected many locked-up shops.
