

# The Goat I Killed Changed To Human Being, Says Murder Suspect

Olise Obi of Ogbeowele Quarters in Issele-Uku headquarters of Aniocha North Local Government Area of Delta State is in the custody of the state's police command over the killing of one Uche Obi.

But the suspect, who admitted having sexual intercourse with his mother at the same scene, where he allegedly committed the crime, claimed it was a goat he killed on September 10, this year, in his farm and was surprised to see the goat transform into a human being.

The Commissioner of Police, Delta State, Mr. Udom Ekpoudom, who paraded the suspect before reporters, said the suspect confessed that, "he went to his mother's cassava farm (on the fateful day) where he saw about 15 goats destroying his crops.

"He said further that he started chasing them out of the farm, but 14 out of the 15 goats ran out of the farm but a recalcitrant one refused to move out.

"He stated that at that point he picked up an axe and hit the goat but behold, the injured goat changed to a human being and died."

Consequently, the suspect was said to have taken to his heels and went into hiding, but police detectives went after him upon receiving the information and arrested him.

The police commissioner further said that the suspect confessed having had sexual intercourse with his mother on the said farm sometime in 2001.

The suspect's arrest was facilitated by the village head, who tipped off the police on the development.

In another development, one Sunday Ndego (25), of Abavo in Ika South Local Government Area of the state, was arrested for allegedly being in possession of a human skull.
