

Man Shot Dead Near Filling Station

The police are trying to unearth the mystery behind the killing of a man who went to visit his friend.

The man was shot dead by armed men suspected to be members of the Oodua Peoples Congress (OPC) last

Friday, September 22, 2006.

Daily Independent gathered that the deceased, Kehinde Mao, who until his death resided at No. 1, Abideen Street, Ajao Estate, Lagos, went to visit his vulcanizer friend at a nearby workshop when he was shot at an uncompleted Filling Station near Osolo Way, Ajao Estate.

Police sources said when a

team of policemen arrived the scene following a tip off, the suspects took to their heels.

Two Pump Action Rifles (PAR) abandoned by the fleeing suspects were recovered.

Lagos State Police Command spokesman, Mr. Olubode Ojajuni, confirmed the report.
