

Three Die In Lagos Auto Crashes

At least three people died in three auto crashes in Lagos at the weekend.

○ In the first accident, a commercial motorcyclist ran into a Mercedes Benz tanker on Saturday.

It was learnt that the rider of the Jincheng motorcycle marked Lagos QS 457 AKD ran into the truck marked Ogun XB 800 SGM and driven by one Mr. Adeola Williams, who is a resident of No.

40, Igi Olugbin Street, Bariga, along Ikorodu Road.

The driver died on the spot.

○ In Ketu on the outskirts of Lagos, a truck crushed a five-year-old boy also at the weekend.

The boy identified as Hammed Sulaimon of No. 4B, Awonusi Street, Ketu, Lagos, was crushed to death on Sunday at Ladipo Street, Ketu, Lagos by a DIANA truck marked Lagos BF 362 AKD and driven by one Lanre Onakoya.

○ In the third accident, a Bedford lorry marked Ogun QQ 866 JBD

lost its control and ran into a tree along Agbowo - Itokin Road, Epe on Sunday.

The driver, Fatai Idowu, died on the spot. Two other occupants of the lorry were injured.

They were taken to a nearby hospital where they are receiving treatment.

The Lagos State Police Public Relations Officer, Olubode Ojajuni, a Deputy Superintendent of Police, confirmed the reports. He said the corpses had been deposited at mortuaries for post-mortem examination.
