

Another Road Accident Claims Two In Lagos

Tragedy occurred again in Lagos when two people lost their lives in an early morning auto crash on Sunday.

The accident occurred along WAMCO/Guinness Junction, ACME Road, Ogba, involving a bullion van and a Honda Accord saloon car.

It was learnt that the two vehicles had a head on collision.

The bodies of the two victims, a man and a woman, were laid by the roadside.

However, the crash caused a

heavy traffic jam along the route for few hours before it was cleared by traffic policemen.

When contacted, the Lagos State Police Public Relations Officer, Olubode Ojajuni, said the command did not have record of such accident.

The Sunday accident occurred barely 24 hours after more than 20 people died in a road accident in Ikorodu in Lagos.

That accident occurred at Agric bus stop in Ikorodu. It involved four vehicles.

Witnesses said that at exactly 4.30p.m a crane, which was heading towards Lagos, lost control and crushed three vehicles, including a

commercial bus picking passengers at the popular Agric bus stop.

Petty traders hawking baked beans, banana and other wares by the roadside were not spared in the accident.

It was learnt that the Leyland Crusader crane belonging to Equip Hold Leasing Heavy Equipment Plant and registered at First Gate Tin Can Island, Apapa, Lagos initially claimed two men sitting on it before it finally ran over three vehicles, a Ford bus marked Ogun XD 323 AAB, a Toyota wagon car marked Lagos AG 087 BDG and an Ikorodu/Ebute-Ero bound bus, which was picking passengers at the bus stop.
