

Car Crushes Pedestrian, Injures Two Others

One person was feared dead while two others were injured when a vehicle ran into them on Awolowo Way, Ikeja in Lagos.

A Mercedes Benz saloon car marked Ogun AY 170 AAB driven by one Teslim Shoyebi crushed the three pedestrians when they wanted to cross the road.

A woman identified as Halima died on the spot, while two unidentified male adults were injured.

Traffic policemen attached to Ikeja Division removed the corpse and deposited it at the Ikeja General Hospital mortuary for post-mortem examination.

The two other victims, who survived the crash, were rushed to a nearby hospital for treatment.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Olubode Ojajuni a deputy superintendent of police, confirmed the report.

He, however, warned pedestrians to be careful when they want to cross the highway especially as the Yuletide is approaching.

The police image-maker advised Lagosians to make use of the pedestrian bridges wherever necessary to stem wanton loss of lives along major roads in the city.
