

Ikeja Airport Hotel Manager Found Dead In His Car

Ikeja Airport Hotel Manager, Mr. Leo, in charge of Chinese Restaurant, was in the early hours of Thursday found dead inside his car in front of the hotel, at Obafemi Awolowo road, Ikeja.

The manager, a Chinese national, in his late forties, was found at the back seat of his White coloured Honda Accord Ex

Class model; with registration number BS 228 SMK, lying face down in the pool of his blood.

As at the time of filing this report, the remains of Leo was still in the car, parked at the Area F of the Ikeja Police Station, while homicide detectives are battling to unravel the circumstances and motive behind the murder.

A bottle of Ragolis bottled water, a pack of Benson and Hedges cigarette, and a lighter are the items found in the car while a car

sticker of WEMABOD Housing Estate, Ikeja Residence was pasted on the windscreen of the car, suggesting that he lives in the estate.

Meanwhile, the police are working on the theory that Leo's personal driver may be of assistance in the investigations, because according to information, he does not drive his car and must be in company of his driver while in the car.

Following this development,

the police have mounted a man-hunt for the driver to determine whether he was the in company of his boss as at the time of the crime, and if so, where is he now and what role did he play.

Ikeja Police Area Commander, Habila Joshale, was seen inspecting the car where he said the crime must have been carried out by professionals going by the way the corpse was concealed in the back seat of the car.
