Student, 20, Stabs Brother To Death

A 20-year-old 400 level medical student of the Ahmadu Bello University (ABU) Zaria, Kabiru Audu, is currently cooling his feet at the Gombe State Criminal Investigation Department (CID) for stabbing to death his brother Aminu Audu, a Law student of the University of Maiduguri.

The Aminu and Kabiru are sons of a renowned medical doctor based in Gombe but of different mothers. He methis untimely death following a brawl after Aminu reportedly turned down Kabiru's request to give him a ride in their father's car in Gombe metropolis. His refusal drew Kabiru's anger, which later developed into a fight. It was gathered that in the course of the fight, Kabiru drew a knife with

which he stabbed Aminu in the stomach. He died on the spot. As Aminu lay dead, Kabiru attempted to bolt but was apprehended by the onlookers. The police later took him to the State CID

where he is currently being detained for interrogation.

Speaking with reporters at the State CID, Kabiru expressed remorse over his conduct, saying he never intended to kill his brother.

He pleaded for forgiveness from the father and police.

Confirming the incident, the Assistant Commissioner of Police in charge of investigation at the Gombe State CID, Mr. Salisu Fagge, said the police were still investigating the matter. He said after investigation, the matter would be taken to court.
