

Two Die, 10 Cars Burnt In PH Tanker Accident

Not fewer than two persons have been confirmed dead, and 10 cars including other valuables, following an accident involving an oil tanker along the Garrison area of Port Harcourt-Aba Road in Rivers State.

Eyewitness said the accident occurred about 5 a.m. when the tanker bearing petroleum product apparently lost control and went headlong along the foot bridge built across the road exploding in flames.

The fire, according to them, went wild, consuming everything around, including about 10 cars parked in the area.

Passers-by could not do anything to save the burnt cars as they ran away for their dear lives.
