## Two Pedestrians Crushed In Lagos

At separate road mishaps in Lagos at the weekend, two pedestrians were killed when

vehicles hit them. In one of the mishaps at Doyin Bus stop, along Badagry Expressway last Saturday, a commercial bus with Lagos registration number, XN 286 EKY ran over an unidentified male pedestrian when he wanted to cross the highway.

The driver of the vehicle, Chinanasor Okeke, of No. 15, Owolabi Street, Aguda, Surulere, allegedly knocked down the victim who gave up the ghost

on the spot. Similarly, a lady, Victoria Ochei, met her untimely death when a saloon car ran over her along Awoyokun Junction,

Onipanu, Lagos.

Ochei, who until her death resided at No. 4, Awoyokun Street, Onipanu, wanted to cross the service lane to board a commercial bus at the junction when the Volkswagen Jetta saloon car CH 61 LSD (Lagos), driven by Tajudeen Odesanmi, a resident of Block 507, Flat 1, Oke-Afa Street, Isolo, Lagos ran over

Good Samaritans quickly rushed her to a nearby hospital but she died while receiving

treatment.

Lagos State Police Command Spokesman, Mr. Olubode Ojajuni, confirmed the two incidents and said that the corpses had been deposited at mortuaries public postmortem examinations
