

# Robbers Invade Lagos Hotel

Dare-devil armed robbers numbering about 15, invaded an hotel at Satellite Town, Lagos on Monday, robbing customers and other occupants.

However, the robbing spree ran into hiccup as two policemen on guard at the hotel engaged the robbers in a fierce gun duel, killing one of them while the others escaped with bullet wounds.

The case is now under investigations at the State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID), Panti-Yaba.

In another incident, the police have begun investigation into the murder on Sunday of two people— one in Ajangbadi and the other on Lagos Island.

The victim at Ajangbadi, was one Emmanuel Ukpong of No.2 Omolola Street, Afromedia. He was allegedly beaten to a state of coma by an angry mob after

unlawfully having carnal knowledge of a seven-year old girl (name withheld). He was later rushed to a nearby hospital where he died.

On Lagos Island, Abdulfatai Alamuye was reportedly shot death while playing football at Balogun Street, by one Gbolahan whose other name and address are unknown.

The police have visited scenes of the two incidents and removed the corpses to public mortuary for autopsy.
