10 Feared Dead In Ajah Clash

•Oba's Palace Razed

Ten people were feared dead on Thursday in an early morning clash between those claiming to be natives of Ajah, a suburb of Lagos, and those loyal to the traditional ruler, Fatai Olumegbon.

Eyewitnesses said men spoiling for a showdown with the monarch to 're-claim', the land went bananas and terrorised every one with deadly weapons.

Children and students going to school were caught up in the

stampede that broke out. The palace of Olumegbon and other properties were razed, and residents who survived the violence fled for refuge in neighbouring towns and vil-
