# Rainstorm Kills Two, Destroys 120 Houses In Plateau

Rainstorm has wreaked havoc on Vang community in Jos South Local Government of Plateau State.

The Tuesday storm killed two people, destroyed over 120 houses and rendered about 800

indigenes of the community homeless.

Most of the affected families have relocated to nearby villages to seek temporary refuge with friends and extended family members.

The victims have appealed to the state and local governments to come to their aid to enable

them rebuild their homes.

Chairman of the council, Daniel Dungs, and the Executive Secretary of the Plateau State Emergency Relief Agency, Mr Pius Gimba, have visited the affected community to sympathise with the people.

They described the incident as a big disaster. They promised that

the state government and the council would do everything to alleviate the suffering of the victims. Senator-elect for Plateau North senatorial district, Gyang Dantong, who also visited the Vang community on Wednesday, expressed shock over the magnitude of the destruction caused by the rainstorm.

He donated N50,000 as his contribution towards the welfare of those whose property were destroyed in the disaster.

It was also learnt that the rainstorm partially destroyed the buildings of the state-owned School of Nursing in the area thereby disrupting academic activities.
