Police Inspector Kills Welder Over Girlfriend

A 25-year old welder, Gbenga Ade, has been shot dead by a Police Inspector in Benin City, Edo State, for allegedly raping the op's girltriend.

The incidence threw the Obamwonyi Street in Oliha Quarters in the city metropolis into confusion and pandemonium. The tragedy also reverberated both in the Central Hospital Benin and the University of Benin Teaching Hospital (UBTH) where doctors

battled in vain from the early hours of Thursday till about 7:30pm when Ade finally gave up the ghost.
