Two Students Drown In Lagos

Two secondary students drowned on Tuesday after a friendly football match in Lagos. Sources said the victims, Chris-

tian Anusun and Bright Jideonu both 17 years old, were Senior Secondary School (SSS) two students of S&I College situated at No. 4, Nimota Street, Owode-Onirin, Ketu Ikorodu Road.

After a football match they went to swim at Odogun River where they got drowned.

The sources added that when a team of policemen on rescue mission got to the scene, the two students had already given up the ghost.

The team only succeeded in re-

covering their bodies. The state Police Public Relations

Officer, Olubode Ojajuni, confirmed the incident. He said the bodies had been de-

posited at Ikorodu General Hospital mortuary for autopsy. The police image-maker, how-

ever, said investigation into the incident had commenced. Similarly, a commercial LT.28 bus

crushed a male pedestrian to death in Lagos on Monday. According to Ojajuni, the bus

driven by one Taofeek Adekojo ran over the pedestrian, Wasiu Akinpelu, at Akowonjo Road, Idimu when he wanted to cross the highway.

The victim was said to have been rushed to a nearby hospital but died while receiving treatment. His body had been deposited at

a public mortuary for post-mortem examination.
