## Gunmen Kill Man In P'Harcourt

Armed bandits have struck and killed Mr. Prince Echendu at his residence at 8 Olunike Street, Port Harcourt, Rivers State.

Echendu's younger brother, John Echendu, disclosed this to Daily Independent.

He said his late brother was shot by four young men in front of his compound, while returning from work at about 10.50 p.m on Wednesday.

John revealed that the

assailants came with a 406 Peugeot car, which they later abandoned after the

operation.

The late Echendu, 53, was an accountant working with Global International in Port

Harcourt, Rivers State.

The Rivers State Police Public Relations Officer, Mrs. Ireiu Barasua, who confirmed the assassination, also disclosed that the late Echendu was a member of State Police Rivers Community Committee.

The police said Echendu's car which the assassins also stole has been recovered.
