

Mob Kills Four Robbers In Yenagoa

Four armed robbery suspects, who allegedly specialised in robbing with commercial motorcycles in Yenagoa, Bayelsa State, have been burned to death by angry youths.

Three of the suspects were killed along Sani Abacha road, Onopa, while the other was burnt to death at Kpansia. Motorcycles used in the robbery operations were also burnt.

When *Daily Independent* visited the scenes, the suspects' remains were still lying around, just as the mob, which included commercial motorcyclists, were jubilating over the incident.

A witness and commercial motorcyclist, Tony Effiong, said three of the suspects snatched a handbag from an elderly woman at Onopa about 5.30am and immediately zoomed off towards Sani Abacha road, along the Express road.

Effiong said N2,000 was contained in the snatched bag.
