Police Kill Four Robbers In Lagos By Wisdom Patrick and Femi Ogbonnikan, Lagos

Four armed robbers were shot

dead during an encounter with the police in Lagos on Tuesday. Sources said the robbers raided a supermarket at Tin Can Island First Gate, Apapa, before anti-robbery operatives attached to Apapa Division raced to the scene follow-

ing a distress call. On seeing the police, the rob-bers opened fire on them. The police team returned fire. This forced the robbers to flee towards

Mile 2 Bridge but the police team caught up with them after a hot pursuit. During the ensuing encounter, four of the bandits were shot dead while others escaped.

The police recovered a bus and four bags of weeds suspected to be Indian hemp from the robbers. In a related development, the police also arrested a robbery sus-

pect, while others escaped. It was learnt that the robbery suspects were operating in a Volkswagen bus marked Lagos

XH760 EKY along Mobolaji Bank-Anthony Way, Ikeja on Tuesday. Following a tip-off, anti-robbery operatives attached to Ikeja Division went after the robbers

and arrested one of them.
