

Police Arrest Fake Doctor Over Murder In Ondo

Police in Ondo State on Wednesday arrested a 22-year-old man, who has been disguising as a medical doctor, over alleged killing of a pregnant woman.

The quack doctor identified as Hezekiah Abayomi was arrested in Ore, Odigbo Council.

The police team was led by the command's spokesman, Adeniran Aremu.

He said the suspect, who had confessed to the crime, disclosed during interrogation that the woman approached him on Tuesday last week for abortion and that he gave her Vitamin K injection.

He added that the woman came back three days later and complained of back ache. The suspect then gave her analgesic, but the woman died while he went for other drugs to be administered on her.

Aremu, however, said Abayomi insisted that he kept the corpse till the following day after which he dumped it in a bush in the area with the help of one of his friends identified as Josiah. The suspect claimed that he did not remove any part of the deceased.

"We went to the scene with medical doctors from the general hospital and we discovered that the remnants of the body, which was put in a sack, were put under shrubs.

"This is a clear case of ritual murder. He (the suspect) has confessed. The police are still working on it to get further details," Aremu stated.
