

Four Die In Police, Robbers Clash

Armed robbers engaged policemen in a shootout in Lagos State on Wednesday.

At the end of the gun duel, two robbers and two policemen were killed.

The incident occurred at Coconut Bus Stop, Trinity, Apapa, Lagos, at about 11.30 a.m.

Sources told Daily Independent that the robbers, numbering seven and armed with sophisticated weapons, fired the first shot when they fell into anti-robbery operatives from Area 'B' command headquarters, Apapa, who were on routine patrol of Trinity area in the early hours of the day.

The robbers, It was gathered, were on a mission to raid a

bank in the area.

Theý opened fire on sighting the police team, killing two of them on the spot.

But the police were not de-terred. They went after the flee-ing robbers, killing two of them and arresting three others with

bullet wounds.

A Honda Accord saloon car with registration number EF 843 ABL four AK47 rifles, three sledgemmers, two acetylene cylinder gas, a pumping ma-chine and other house-breaking implements were recovered from the gang, Daily Independent gathered.

Contacted, Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) in the state, Olubode Ojajuni, con-

firmed the incident.

According to him, the police team put up a gallant fight cul-minating in the arrest of the suspects.

Two, other Two other policemen wounded in the exchange of fire were receiving treatment at an undisclosed hospital, he said.
