## Robbers Kill Two, Injure Five In FESTAC complex were earlier sent away

Two persons died, while five others were injured in an early morning robbery at the Federal Housing Authority (FHA) Shopping Complex, on 22 Road, in FESTAC Town, in Lagos on Monday.

It was learnt that the robbers came about 3.30 a.m. and started shooting sporadically, while they held some vendors of foreign

currencies hostage.

"The robbers came for those selling foreign currencies. They collected a lot of money from them and killed two people here," a source told the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN).

It was also learnt that the foreign currency vendors at the shopping complex were earlier sent away following insinuations that they usually attract armed robbers to the area.

"This is the fourth time robbers are raiding the FHA shopping complex on 22 Road. In 2004, they killed three persons here. We are tired of the incessant robbery attacks," another source explained. Some residents of 'G' Close said

Some residents of 'G' Close said the robbers woke up the neighbourhood with gunshots.

"When they came in 2004 during which they killed three persons at the complex, they shot at our building. The bulletholes are still on the walls of our house. We call on the police to save us from their incessant attacks," a resident said.
