

Former LG Boss Dies In Auto Crash

A few months after he alleged that popular actress, Toyin Adegbola (a.k.a. Ajoke Asewo to re Mecca) was planning to kill him, former chairman of Ibadan North Local Government Area of Oyo State, Lukman Busari, died on Thursday evening.

Busari, a chieftain of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) in the state and a close associate of Alhaji Lamidi Adedibu died in a motor accident along Ibadan-Osogbo Road.

The late politician late last year alleged that a jeep belonging to Adegbola was used to trail him by some suspected hired assassins.

This subsequently led to the arrest and detention of the popular actress for several days by the state police command.

But death eventually came on Thursday evening when the politician, who served as an aide to Governor Adebayo Alao-Akala of Oyo State during his 11 months in office as the governor of the state in 2006, was returning to Ibadan from a journey.
