Passengers Drown In Warri

An undisclosed number of people were believed to have drowned on Sunday morning in Warri, Delta State, when the vehicle they were travelling in, plunged into a river.

Though details of the accident was scanty at press time, witness account had it that a Peugeot 307 marked Abuja 503 KUJ, sped through the Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA) yard and crashed into a river

Due to the inability of local divers to rescue the trapped passengers, a crane belonging to INTELS was deployed to pull out the vehicle and its occupants.

Sources however said the crane only brought out, heap of files and an Identity Card bearing the name of an Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP), who was believed to have travelled from Abuja.
