

Man Kills Younger Sister

Crack homicide detectives in Lagos have arrested a young man who allegedly hacked his younger sister to death at the weekend.

The suspect, Sunday Emeka, is currently in the custody of the detectives from the homicide section of State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID), Panti Street, Yaba, Lagos.

He is said to be assisting the police in their probe into the killing of the girl, Oluwatoyin Sunday.

Informed police sources hinted that the suspect murdered his younger sister who was staying with him at No. 13, Wharf Road, Ogolonto, Ipakodo, Ikorodu, on Sunday in unclear circumstances.

Lagos State Police Command Public Relations Officer, Frank Mba, confirmed the arrest of the suspect.

But the police spokesman could not ascertain what the suspect used in hacking his younger sister to death.

Mba said detectives visited the crime scene immediately the incident was reported and that they have moved the corpse to Ikorodu General Hospital's mortuary, Beach Road, Ikorodu for postmortem examination.

According to Mba, the suspect was being questioned to ascertain the reasons why he resorted to taking his younger sister's life.

Immediately investigation is concluded, the PPRO assured that the suspect would be arraigned to answer for his crime.
