

Police kill 14-year-old boy In Father's Sitting Room

Tragedy struck in Maitumbi area of Minna, Niger State as a 14-year-old boy, Abubakar Onifade, was killed by a stray bullet from a police officer while watching television in his father's sitting room.

Onifade, who was an SS2 student of Hill Top Secondary School, Minna, was killed while watching a programme on the television at about 8: 45pm on Monday.

It was gathered that bullet pierced through the door of the sitting room and hit the deceased on the chest leading to his death on the spot.

The police officer was said to have engaged some gangsters in combat while on foot patrol around a blackspot in Angwan Roko area of Maitumbi

One of the gangsters it was gathered was said to have stabbed one of the police officers with a knife.
