

Aromire Dies In Auto Crash

The Nigerian entertainment industry was thrown into another mourning mood on Friday, July 4, when ace movie producer and chief executive officer of Oyotomi Cable Television, Alade Aromire, died in a ghastly auto crash along Lagos-Ibadan express way on his way from Mowe in Ogun State.

Aromire was said to have left the LTV 8 on Friday, July 4 at about 5 p.m. to check on his building project in company of another actor identified as *Baba Kekere*.

According to *Baba Kekere*, who sustained minor injuries in the crash, the incident occurred when a trailer load of water melon rammed into their car from behind and the car which was being driven by the late entertainment impresario somersaulted three times.

"It was in the course of the somersault that Aromire was thrown out of the car and hit his head on the ground. I was confused in the melee. I ran out of the car like a mad man. I could not comprehend what was happening," *Baba Kekere* said.

He told *Sunday Independent* that it was passersby who saw the condition of Aromire that brought him to the LTV in a *molue* bus before he was rushed to Duro Soley Hospital on Allen Avenue, Ikeja.
