Suspected Ritualists Kill Man In Ibadan

Residents of Oke-Padre area of Ibadan were thrown into mourning on Thursday morning, when they woke up to behold the gory sight of the lifeless body of a resident simply

identified as Dogo.
Suspected ritualists allegedly
murdered the young man beside the popular Ogunpa River,

while on his way to work in the early hours of yesterday.

The deceased, who was found in the pool of his own blood, had woken and prepared for the work on Thursday, not knowing that he would not live to see his office again.

After killing him, the killers reportedly carried the lifeless body of the deceased to a mechanic village, close to a beer parlour, located beside the Ogunpa River.

As early as 7.00 a.m., bewilder sympathisers from the Oke-Padre area and passers-by had gathered round the copse.

The police were later brought into the matter some community leaders, who reported it at Mokola Police Station, Ibadan.
