Enugu Monarch Kidnapped, Killed

The traditional ruler of Obe in Enugu State, Uche Nwachime, has been killed by gunmen who kidnapped him at the weekend.

The news coincides with the abduction of Paul Edemobi, the younger brother of the Director-General of National Agency for Food and Drug Administration and Control (NAFDAC), Dora Akunyili, who was kidnapped in Enugu on Monday night.

Edemobi is the proprietor of Paul and Grace Foundation, a non-profit organisation located at 10B Savage Crescent, GRA Enugu, which renders free medical services to children and old people.

His captors have demanded a ransom of N30 million for his release. Nwachime was the proprietor of Mac Royal Hotel, Presidential Road, Enugu.

His body was deposited at a dumpsite on the Enugu-Port Harcourt Expressway from where it was recovered.

The proprietor of Grand Riveri Hotel, Enugu was also said to have been abducted a week ago but was released after the payment of N5 million.
