## Oyo Police Kills Two Highway Robbers

Oyo State Police Command has disclosed that two of the armed robbers terrorising commuters on highways in the state have been killed.

The Command explained that the action was part of its efforts to curb incidence of armed robbery on major highways in the state.

Its Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Clabisi Okuwobi, disclosed this on Tuesday while briefing journalists at the Command Headquarters, Eleyele, Ibadan, on behalf of the State Commissioner of Police, Bashir Azeez.

Okuwobi explained that the two
dead robbers met their waterloo
along Ogun River Bridge in Oyo
North area of the state and along
Iseyin/Ago-Amodu Road.

She disclosed that a group of nine "Bororo" Fulani armed robbers had been terrorising commuters at a pointnear Ogun River and that upon learning about their activities, the police quickly dispatched a patrol team to the scene, using a timber

lorry as disguise.
