

Wife Kills London-bound Husband

Andrew Achebinoma, a native of Irhodo, Jesse, Ethiope West Local Government Area, Delta State, has met an untimely death in the hand of one of his wives.

Sources close to the deceased's family said Achebinoma, a graduate of Marketing from the University of Nigeria, Nsukka and Vice Principal of a secondary in Jesse, was billed to travel to London days after he met his death.

He was said to have had a quarrel with one of his wives who was bitter at realising that the deceased had married a London-based nurse who had perfected all necessary travelling documents to enable him join her in London.

Saturday Independent learnt that during a quarrel with his wife, said to have had seven children for her former husband before giving birth one child for Achebinoma, he had said he was tired of the nagging and bickering of his wife.

That statement, according to eye witnesses, infuriated the wife.

Another version of the story by a relative of the late Achebinoma who craved anonymity said that the woman had decided to end her affairs with the deceased.

He stated that the deceased, sensing the collapse of the affairs, asked the woman to pack her property from the house he rented for her.

It was said that when the quarrel had subsided the deceased bent down and was playing with the only child she had for him when she hit him with a big stick. The man died instantly.
