Two Siblings Roasted In Fire Outbreak

Two siblings were at the weekend in Lagos sent to early graves when a mysterious fire gutted their residence.

The incident occurred on Saturday at about 7.00 a.m., at House Number 2/3, Itunuolu Street, Egbe, an outskirt of the city.

The inferno reportedly snuffed lives out of David and Afor Obi.

According to a close family member, candle lit when there was power outage, sparked off the inferno, which affected a block of flat in a storey building the Obis were residing.

However, the timely arrival of fire servicemen from Isolo Fire Station and policemen attached to Ikotun Division prevented the fire from spreading into adjoining buildings.

Frank Mba, Lagos State Police Command spokesman, confirmed the incident.
