

Two Killed In Anambra Bank Robbery

For the fourth time, armed robbers raided two new generation banks in the old Aguata Local Councils of Anambra State. This time the port of call was Umunze, Orumba South Local Government Area where the robbers allegedly killed two persons on Thursday night.

One of victims was said to be a madman while the second believed to be a politician returning from a political

meeting.

It was not clear as at press time the amount carted away by the robbers but an inside source said the banks lost millions of naira.

It was learnt that the suspected madman killed during the operation was believed to have challenged the robbers for disturbing the peace of the community when he was shot dead.

Anambra State Commissioner

of Police, Abbass Mohammed, confirmed the robbery, but denied the casualties. According to him, law enforcement agents are on the trail of the robbers.

It was learnt that the robbers broke into the safe of the banks through the walls after harassing a team of police on duty. They thereafter operated for over four hours.

Bank robbery attacks have become regular in the boundary councils of Aguata, especially Ekwulobia, Orumba North and South and police are seem to be at quandary as to the solution.
