

Two Die As Sokoto Speaker's Convoy Crashes In Nasarawa

Two members of the convoy of the Speaker of Sokoto State House of Assembly, Abdullahi Balarabe Salami, lost their lives at the weekend, during a motor accident.

The accident took place while Salami was returning from Nasarawa Local Government Area (LGA) of Nasarawa State, after being conferred with a chieftaincy title of *Baraden Nasarawa*.

Although none of the occupants of the Speaker's vehicle, including his wife and driver, was harmed, occupants of the other vehicle were not so lucky.

However, the Speaker's wife reportedly sustained minor bruises.

The Speaker's car was also badly damaged, while the Honda car, with registration number AJ 330 SBG Kaduna, was damaged beyond

recognition, as it was broken into two.

Daily Independent gathered that the Salami and his wife were immediately taken to the Federal Medical Centre (FMC), Keffi, by the convoy of Nasarawa State Speaker, Mohammed Ahmed from where they were transferred to the National Hospital, Abuja.

It was also gathered that the bodies of the deceased have been deposited at the General Hospital, Akwanga, Nasarawa State.
