

Three Die In *Okada* Accidents In Lagos

Three persons at the weekend died in two separate *Okada* accidents in Lagos.

In the first accident that occurred at about 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, an unidentified commercial motorcyclist, conveying a lone passenger rode against traffic at Trade Fair Complex, before it collided head on with a Mercedes Benz Saloon car, marked AR 68 KSF (Lagos), and driven by one Pat Eneh.

The motorcyclist and the unidentified passenger died on the spot.

Similarly, another *Okada* operator was last Friday sent to his early grave.

The accident occurred at Five-Star Hotel Bus stop, Apapa/Oshodi Expressway.

Police sources said a Mercedes Benz Lorry, marked DL 04 LSR (Lagos), driven by one Ikechukwu Chinedu, rammed into the *Okada* operator and the latter sustained serious injuries before he was rushed to a nearby, undisclosed hospital for treatment.

It was gathered that it was while receiving treatment that the *Okada* rider gave up the ghost.

Frank Mba, Lagos State Police Command Public Relations Officer, disclosed that corpses from the two accidents had been removed and deposited at undisclosed public mortuaries for post mortem examinations.
