### Bloody Easter: 16 Militants, Naval Rating Killed In Bayelsa

\*37 Perish In Auto Crashes

Road accidents claimed at least 37 lives in Ilorin and Katsina on Sunday, besides the 24 who died in Kano and Owerri in the run up to Easter.

And tragedy hit Igbomotoru and Nembe in Bayelsa State, where 16 militants and a Naval rating were killed between Sunday night and Monday morning in gun battles with the Joint Task Force (JTF).

Ten militants, two Naval men, and one soldier were injured in the attacks, in which the JTF sank four speed boats belonging to armed youths.

It was learnt that 20 militants travelling in six boats were returning from their hide-out after robbing and raping victims in Okilo creek, Igbomotoru.

Based on a tip off, JTF personnel were on the alert as the militants closed in on their location and fired gun shots as troops defended an Agip facility and themselves at Tebidaba flow station.

JTF Spokesman, Rabe Abubakar, said the JTF returned fire, resulting in the sinking of four boats belonging to the militants.

He added that "the leader of the militants, Ogunbos, was responsible for attacks destruction of houseboats belonging to Daewoo Nigeria employees stationed at Igbomotoru working for Agip.

"This and other heinous crimes committed by (Ogunbos) and his unpatriotic men made the JTF being a custodian of security of life and property in

the Niger Delta - to pledge to trail him and apprehend him, so as to serve as a deterrent to others.

"However, our actions are not retaliatory but for enforcing peace and order in the region."

Abubakar noted that another attack on Monday by another militant group, led by Kitikata and Fara Dagogo, at a Nembe facility owned by Shell was a reprisal against the killing of the eight militants.

He said a Naval man was killed, two received inquiries, and the attackers stole four speed boats belonging to Shell.

He disclosed that the JTF is hunting for the militants "who would pay dearly in the event of any other attack on locations and economic facilities, as we have resolved to carry out a decisive and appropriate response within the provision of our mandate."

Twenty four deaths in the road accidents took place at Kanbi village near Ilorin when two buses collided in trying to avoid hitting a commercial motorcyclist. Ten passengers received injuries.

An eyewitness said the accident occurred at the night when the motorcyclist crossed the road.

Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) officials from Jebba rescued the survivors and evacuated the dead.

In Katsina State, 13 members of a family, including women and children, died in an accident at Dungun-Ma'azu village on the Funtua-Dandume Road.

They were returning from a wedding in Minna.

Eye witnesses said the tyre of their vehicle got burst and led to the crash Only the driver and the conductor survived.

Abdulbasir Kafinta, who lost his wife and daughter, described the incident as an act from Allah.

Six other persons died in another road accident on Saturday in Malumfashi, Katsina State.
