11 Perish In Kano Auto Crash

It was yet another week of tragedy in Kano State when 11 persons perished in an auto crash which occurred in Tambarawa, about 20 kilometres to Kano City.

The accident is believed to have been caused by the recent fuel scarcity which has hit Kano and other cities in the

country.

The 11 passengers were burnt beyond recognition while seven other survivors of the accident had been rushed to the Murtala Mohammed Specialist Hospital for the treatment of varying degrees of burns and other injuries they sustained in the incident.

Sources disclosed that the tragedy occurred when a Gulf car said to be carrying some fuel in jerry cans crashed into a stationary bus disembarking

passengers.

The crash resulted in both vehicles going up in flames, roasting 11 of the passengers instantly and leaving seven others with severe burns.
