An eye-witness told Daily Independent that the accident took place about 7.30 p.m. when the driver of the truck lost control of the vehicle while he was frantically trying to clear it from the road.

According to the witness, the two policemen on a motor cycle met their untimely death when the truck hit them just as two other persons were also injured. Meanwhile, the bodies of the two

policemen have been deposited at the Asokoro General Hospital while those who sustained injury are

receiving treatment in the same hospital. Confirming the incident, the Unit Commander of Federal Road Safety Commission, Nyanya, Godwin Apochi, said the cause of the accident
