

Assassins Kill Bizman In Warri

Residents of Ogborikoko in Warri, have been thrown into mourning following the gruesome murder of a marine and haulage magnate, Lucky Ojo, at his residence by unknown gunmen.

It was gathered that the gangsters gained entrance into his apartment through a

window in the visitors' room after cutting the iron protector at the wee hours of the fateful day.

Wife of the deceased, Mrs. Faith Ojo, who witnessed the murder, recounted the gory incident, saying the family was already fast asleep when suddenly four young men, fully armed gained entrance into their room searching for her husband with a torchlight.

The widow, who is heavy with

pregnancy, said she thought it was a dream as the assailant walked close to her and her husband on the bed and told him, "we were asked to come and kill you by the man you are having a matter with in court and there is nothing you will do to stop us from carrying out this work; we have been paid for it and you cannot beg us. We are also asked to trail your people especially members of your family."
