

Four Corps Members Killed In Auto Crash In Kano

Kano secretariat of the National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) and its camp in Karaye, a local government in Kano, have been thrown into mourning following the death of four members in a motor accident along the Kano-Karaye road.

Three of the victims died on the spot when their bus was in-

volved in an accident were on evangelical assignment.

The deceased corps members were identified as Miss Geraldine Uloma Ikebunna, (27) who hailed from Okwe, Onuimo local government area of Imo state; Mathais Paul Idah from Okpoga, Okpokwu local government area of Benue State and Akaduchi Peter Ifechukwude (26) of Akwumazi-Umuocha, Inika

North East of Delta State.

The fourth victim, Lawrence Idoko, who also hailed from Kogi State, died on Wednesday at the Aminu Kano Teaching Hospital.

Sources said the bodies of the deceased have been conveyed home for burial.

At the NYSC secretariat on BUK road, the pictures of the Catholic corps members were pasted conspicuously on the no-

tice board and other strategic places.

The deceased corps members according to information from the NYSC office were to have concluded their primary assignments in September.

Efforts to get the state director of the NYSC to comment on the tragedy was fruitless as he was said to be unavailable in the office when our correspondent called to get his reaction.
