Riot Scare In Lagos As Police Kill Car Washer

There was pandemonium at the weekend in Iju-Ishaga, a suburb of Lagos, as residents protested the death of a car washer shot dead by an officer in the police anti-robbery squad.

But the police rose to the occasion by dispersing the people with teargas.

An Armoured Personnel Carrier (APC) was later stationed at Ishaga Round About, known as the abode of area boys and hoodlums, to prevent them from cashing in on the incident.

Burn fires littered the roads in the area on Sunday, apparently made by the boys who had already set ablaze the post used by traffic wardens at Ishaga bus stop

The rioters moved to enter the police station but were prevented by anti-riot policemen, led by the Divisional Police Officer, Remy Ogbonna.

Many versions were narrated of the incident that led to the death of Dele Shodipo, 30, an automobile rewire technician who doubled as a car washer.

One said he had a quarrel with his girlfriend, Rose, whose mother is a Nigerian and father a Ghanaian.

Rose was said to have reported the matter to the police, who came to arrest Shodipo, who in turn, engaged the officers in an argument that led to firing of gun

shorts to scare the people.

The bullet reportedly hit him on the leg.

Shodipo, who was married with two children, was taken to the hospital where he

gave up the ghost.

Other sources said both he and a policeman were dating Rose, and when she had a misunderstanding with him she called on her policeman lover who mobilised his colleagues to bring Shodipo to the station.

There was a mild resistance from Shodipo who told the officers that it was a minor dispute between him and Rose that did not require police intervention.

The argument made a police corporal in the team to fire a shot which hit him on

the left leg, and he started bleeding.

He was rushed by policemen to Pacific Hospital in Iju where he was given first aid.

But the hospital said it could not handle the injury.

Ogbonna, the DPO, reportedly disarmed and ordered the detention of the officers and personally took Shodipo to the hospital.

Police Public Relations Officer, Frank Mba, confirmed the incident, but denied that it had to do with Shodipo and the policeman dating Rose.

He said a case of rape was reported, and the officers, knowing the volatile nature of the area where the offence was allegedly committed, went with a patrol van and arms to invite the suspect.

Mba alleged that Shodipo resisted arrest and hoodlums attacked the police, which made the officer to fire gun shots into the air to scare them.

A stray bullet hit the deceased on the leg, according to Mba, who added that Rose

has been arrested and put in protective custody to prevent reprisals against her. He said investigation of the case has begun, and the officer who shot Shodipo has been arrested and transferred to the State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID), Panti in Yaba for discreet interrogation.

"The command will not spare any policeman who uses fire arm unlawfully," Mba pledged.
