

Two Die In Lagos Road Mishaps

Two pedestrians were on Monday crushed to death in separate road accidents in Lagos.

In the first incident, it was gathered that a Toyota car marked GA 641 AAA (Lagos) driven by one Abdulrasaq Ugbo-daga of Suit 21, Grand View Plaza, Magodo Estate, Ketu, Lagos, ran over an unidentified male pedestrian when he wanted to cross the ever-busy Ibadan Expressway.

The incident occurred at about 3.30 p.m.

Also, a truck reportedly crushed another unidentified male pedestrian to death at Orile-Iganmu on Monday at about 11.30 a.m.

It was learnt that the male victim wanted to cross the road when the approaching truck, marked XP 847 SMK (Lagos), ran over him at Orile Bus Stop.

Lagos State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Frank Mba, confirmed the incidents, saying the driver of the Mercedes Benz truck, Joseph Tyavkase, a resident of Number 26, Yewa Street, Isolo, lost control before it crushed him.
