

Governor's Aide Dies In Auto Crash

SENIOR Special Adviser to Kano State Governor on Women Affairs, Hajiya Maryam Imam, has died in a ghastly motor accident along Damaturu-Potiskum road.

According to a witness, the adviser was travelling to Maiduguri for the weekend in her Peugeot 406 saloon car when a tanker vehicle hit her car, forcing it into bush where she sustained serious injuries on the head and died instantly with her driver.

The corpse was deposited at the Potiskum General Hospital mortuary prior to the time Kano State government was informed of the incidence which also communicated to Yobe State government, as some top officials were mobilised to ensure proper arrangement of the conveyance of the corps to Maiduguri for burial.

Those at the mortuary included the Chairman of Potiskum Local Government Area, Alhaji Lawan Musa, staff of the Government House, Damaturu Protocol department, politicians, traditional title holder among others.

Associates to the late adviser described her dead as a great loss to Kano women and Kano State.
