RESIDENTS of Kano, the Kano State capital, were thrown into mourning on Wednesday night

when fire claimed 12 lives mostly guests at a naming ceremony scheduled for Thursday.

It was said to have exploded as fuel was being poured into the

tank while the engine was on. The explosion, it was gathered, resulted in huge ball of fire, which consumed the entire block.

Alleging mystery into the fire which occurred at about 10.30 p.m., a source within the neighborhood, who refused to be named, told our correspondent that during the explosion, frantic

efforts were made to extinguish the fire. The source stated further that to the surprise of everyone the

engulfed the first floor of the storey building.

It was learnt that the victims were family members of one Kabiru Boss from Nafada area of Gombe State, who was in Kano to attend the naming of his new

born baby, Umaru Kabiru.

Among the dead were the mother of Chairman of Nafada Local Government Council and four members of his family, all from Nafada. Their ages range between 10

and 38 years. Also dead included
