

Four Arrested Over Alleged Killing Of Youth Leader

YOUTHS in Oghara headquarters of Ethiope West Council of Delta State, on Thursday protested the alleged killing of another youth over minor disagreement.

Sources said the irate youths razed eight houses, including the home of a traditional title holder who allegedly owned the gun used in the alleged killing.

However, calm was restored to the town when *Daily Independent* visited the area, but sources said some of youths had protested the circumstance surrounding the death of the youth's leader.

Trouble was said to have started when the youths were informed that one Chief Godstime Agidotan was the alleged owner of the 'gun' used in the alleged killing of the youth.
