

Two Youths Docked Over Murder

TWO YOUTHS have been put in the dock before the Ebute-Metta Magistrate's court in Lagos for alleged murder.

The defendants, Afeez Lamidi (19) and Ahmed Salaudeen (21) were alleged

to have killed one Tobi Anifowose in Ikorodu area of Lagos with broken knife on May 17, 2010.

Part of the two-count charge read: "That you Afeez Lamidi and Ahmed Salaudeen and others still at large on May

17, 2010 at about 11pm at 9, Pashoku Street, Aka, Ikorodu, a suburb of Lagos in the Lagos Magisterial District did unlawfully killed Tobi Anifowose, by stabbing him with a broken bottle and knife.

The prosecution said the

offence is contrary to and punishable under sections 324 and 319 (1) of the criminal code cap 17 volume 2 laws of Lagos State of Nigeria, 2003.

The defendants pleaded not guilty to the charges preferred against them, but

the presiding Magistrate, Mrs. K. O. Deja-Ojo refused to grant them bail and ordered that they be remanded at the Ikoyi Prisons in Lagos.

The court consequently adjourned the case to August 18, 2010 for further hearing.
