

Suspected militants kill mother of two in Delta

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A BAYELSA State-based trader, Madam Bawolulu Otit, has allegedly been killed by suspected militants near Oghara, Delta State, after months of trying to secure her safety from the hands of assailants in Kaiama, Bayelsa State.

The deceased was said to be living in Kaiama with her nephew, Jeffrey Unokan, before their prob-

lems with militants, arising from attempt to get Jeffrey to join in the militancy activities which the family resisted.

According to sources, Otit and her two children escaped from Kaiama to Delta State where she lived in hiding before her reported disappearance.

Sources said she may have been kidnapped and killed by suspected militants on her trail in search of her fleeing nephew.
